Dear Pre-K Parent or Guardian,

We are ready to begin the 100 Book Challenge Pre-Kindergarten Reading Program. Every night your child will bring home one or two (or more) books that they have chosen to read and talk about with you. Our goal is for every child to listen to and/or "picture read" 500+ books this year!

We need your help! Every night your child will bring home books and a logbook. Each logbook line equals one title. Your child should listen to 2-4 titles read aloud each night. After you and your child read a book, please write the title of the book in the logbook, write the date, and sign under "Coach's Signature."

While you are reading to your child, be sure your child is following the story pages from left to right and using the pictures to help tell the story. They should be talking with you about the book and having fun while doing so.

We are requesting that you sign on as your child's Home Coach. The job involves only five things. Please complete and return the bottom portion of this form tomorrow to let us know you agree to be the Home Coach.

Home Coach Contract

- ☆ Turn off TV, computers, phone, and games.
- ☆ Read 2 to 4 books aloud to your child.
- ☆ Think and talk about the books afterward.
- ☆ Sign 100 Book Challenge logsheets.
- ☆ Student packs up books for safe return to school.

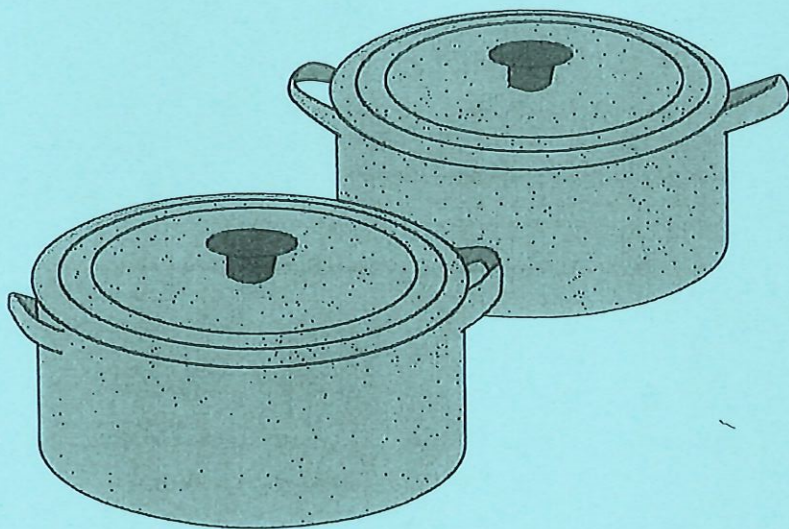

Raising a Reader

Recipe for Raising a Reader

1. Talk to the child when you are together.
2. Listen to the child. Ask the child questions. Listen to the child's answers.
3. Read to the child every day. Read lots of books.
4. Talk about the books.
5. Encourage the child to look at books by themself. Let the child "tell" the story from just the pictures.
6. Let the child see you reading: books, magazines, newspapers, etc.
7. Make sure there are always lots of books everywhere in the child's house—kitchen, living room/family room, bedroom, bathroom—and in the car.
8. Encourage the child to write and draw. Make sure the child has lots of paper, crayons, pencils, markers, etc.
9. Let the child see you writing: lists, letters, notes, etc.
10. Take the child to the library and bookstore often.
